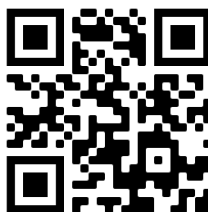

A Conversation with EnviroWorkshops Executive Director Travis Bowman



Travis, please give us an overview of your background in the environmental remediation industry.

I was the sales and marketing director at an environmental industry firm in the Carolinas that had a proprietary technology that significantly reduced the cost of cleaning up hydrocarbons and VOCs in contaminated soil, so I was bidding on sole-source projects all over the Southeast.

Eventually, I left that company and began my own independent sales consulting firm, representing ISCO and ISCR technologies, bioremediation technologies and a range of new technologies. While networking at conferences all over the country, the idea for Enviroworkshops was born.

How did participating in those conferences lead to creating Enviroworkshops?

I got the idea: "Instead of driving all over an area, what if all those needing the information I'm offering meet together? I could provide lunch and present information to everyone at once on the various available remediation technologies."

That was the initial Remediation Workshop, but it grew rapidly. I terminated my sales relationships to eliminate conflicts of interest. I wanted to create a truly unbiased offering of information on the various kinds of technologies available in the industry. Later, offering CEUs was added to increase the benefits to workshop attendees.

We're in our 10th year of Enviroworkshops. Over 25,000 have registered for a workshop, and we've held over 400 workshops on six continents. We have quickly become the largest environmental training organization worldwide.

Where do you see Enviroworkshops headed in the future?

In addition to our remediation workshops, we are expanding our repertoire to include brand new themes, such as PFAS Remediation, BioRemediation, Hydrocarbons & Halogens, PFOS, Energy & Environment, and more.

What do you enjoy most about your job?

I remember years ago being part of a project to clean up the contamination from a gas station in rural North Carolina. The gas station had closed years early, but an older woman who lived across the highway approached me and told me how grateful she was that gas station site was finally being cleaned up. She shared that whenever she used her hose to water her garden, the water smelled like gasoline. I thought, "If that's what she's having to put on her garden, what's in the water she's drinking?!"

If you go to a third world country, you can't drink the water there, but we tend to take safe drinking water for granted. It's great to be in this industry, cleaning up contaminants so that people can drink clean water.
